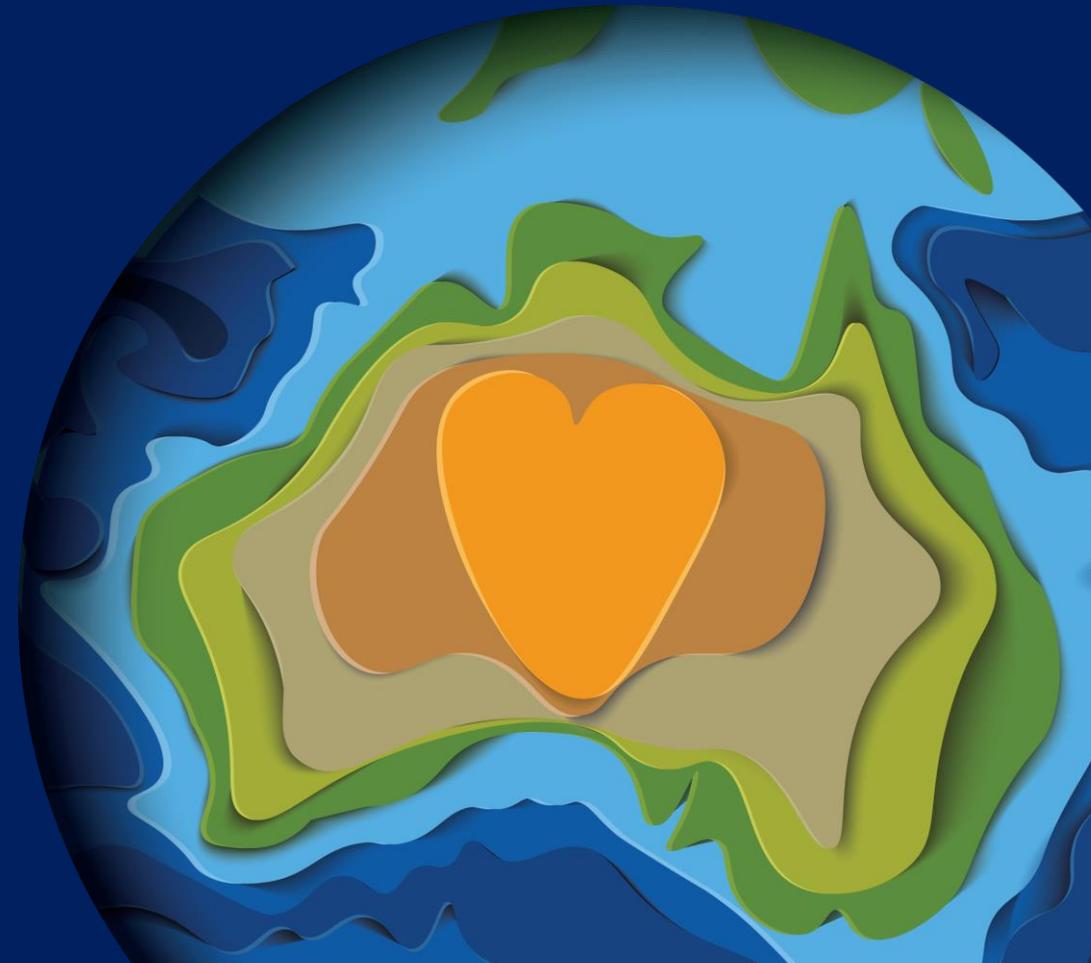

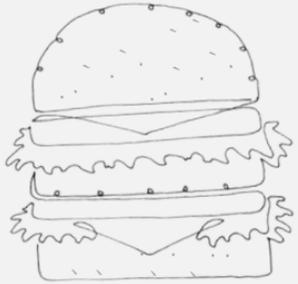

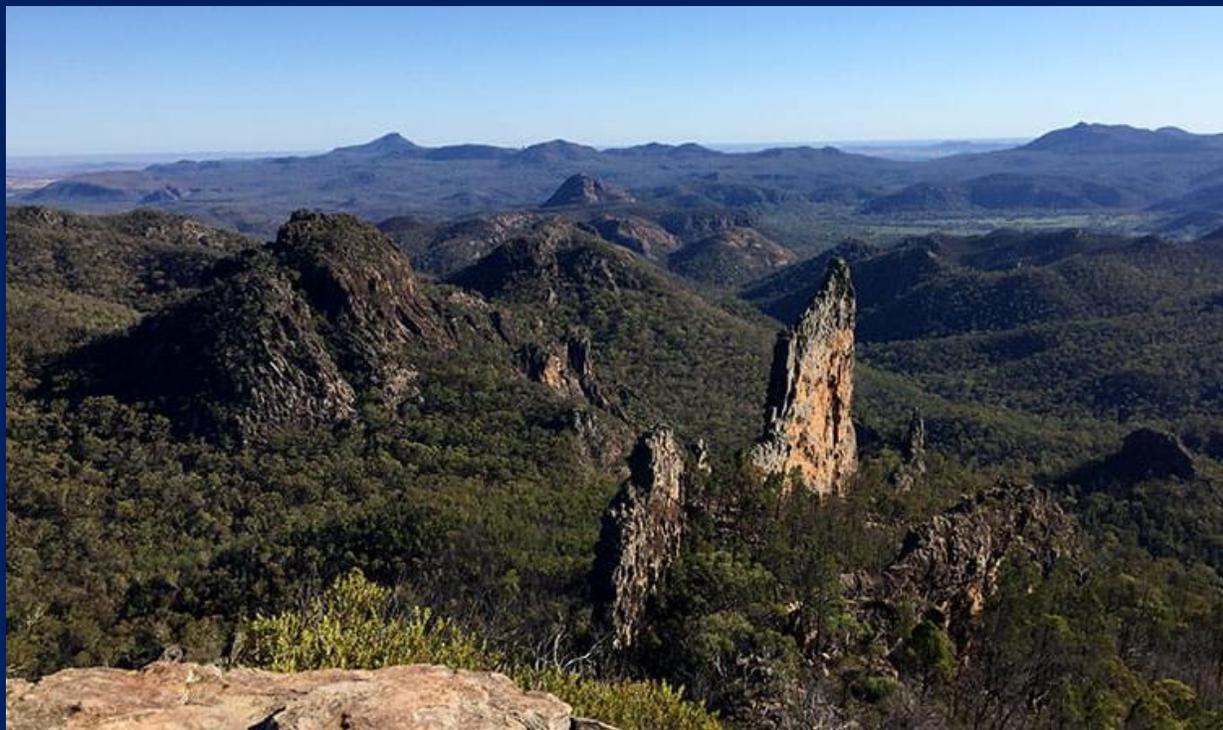

Intervention scales... up to a point



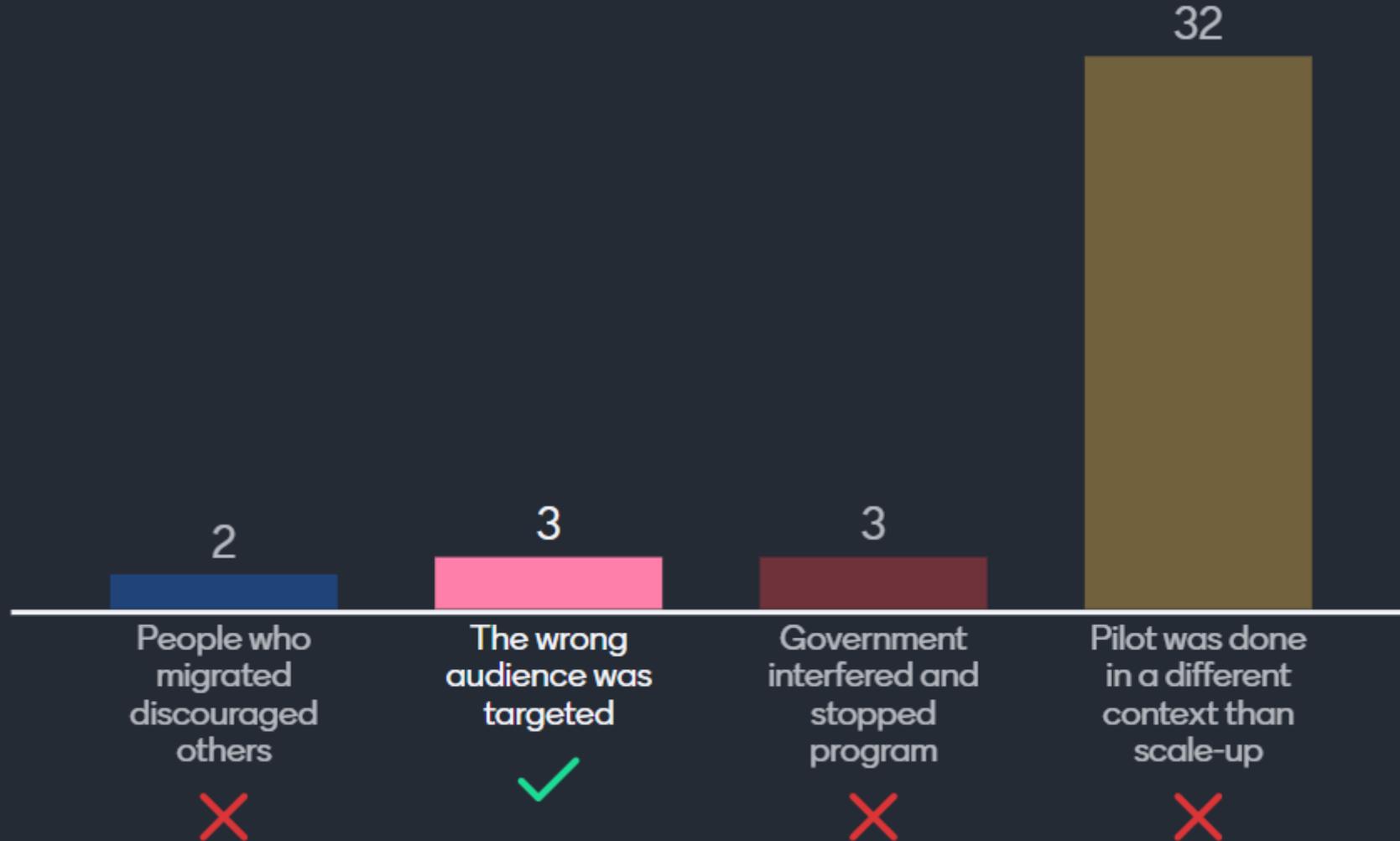
22 pp increase in migration

day: families**

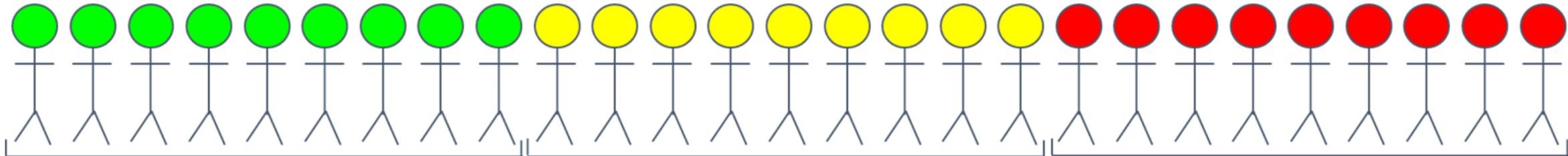


**Max. 12 pp increase in
migration**

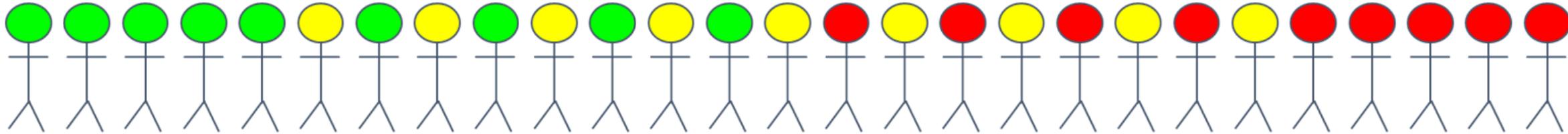

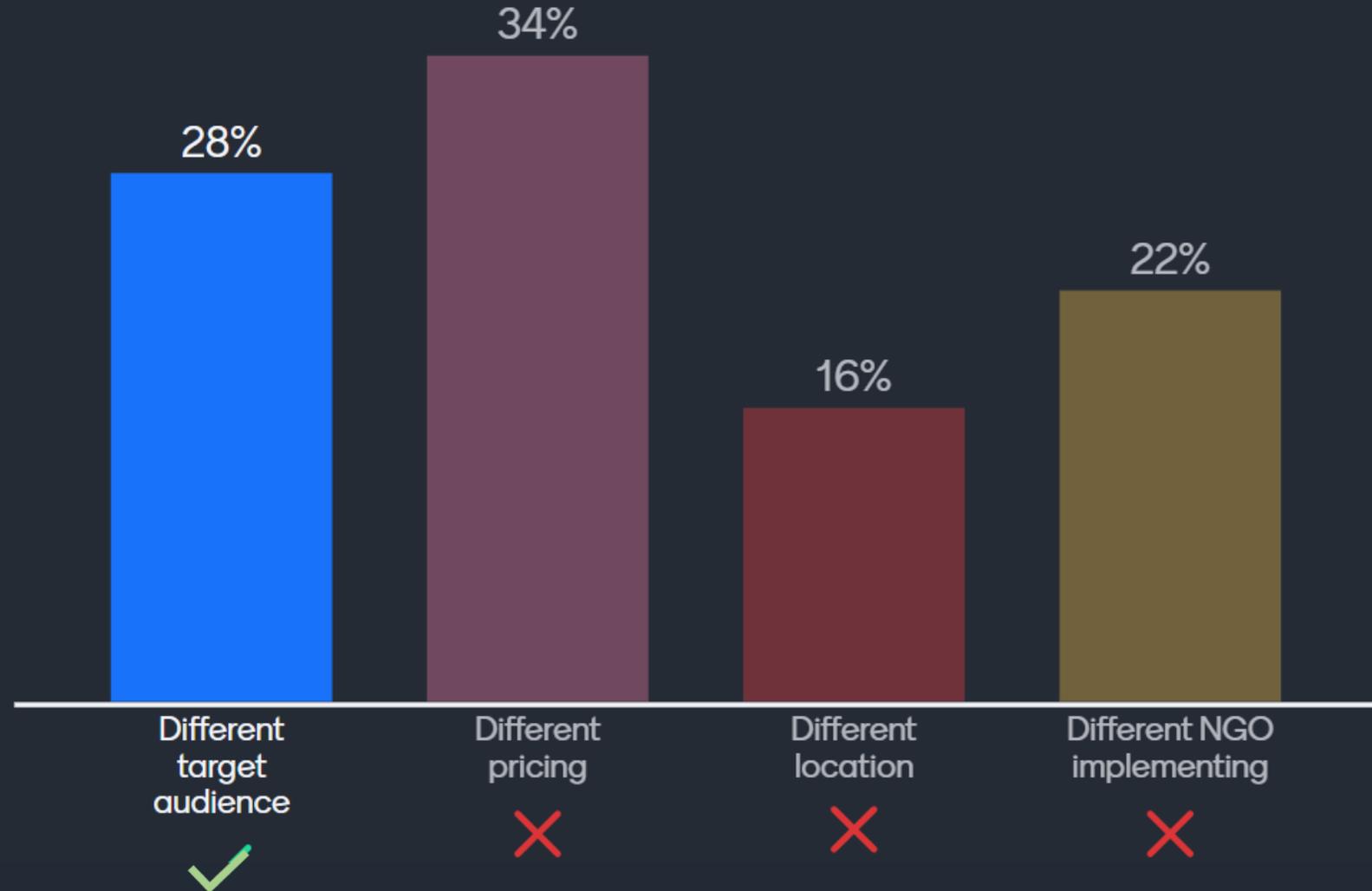

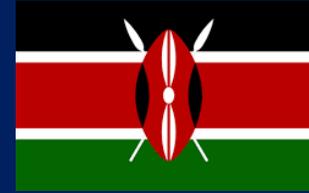

Govt: no effect

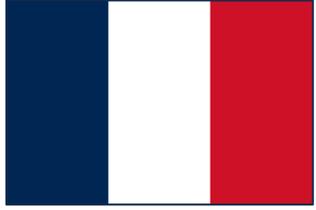
Why didn't it work when government implemented?

others (displacement)

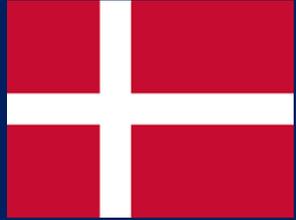
